

# MAKE A SEEDBOMB

**We can't change the world,  
but we can change our small corner!**

Grow your own pollinator friendly Irish Wildflowers and fill your garden with Bees and Pollinators. Have some more fun by making some Seedbombs! In a Seedbomb, the seeds are mixed with compost and clay, making it a quick and more effective way of planting wildflower seeds than merely scattering them.

## HOW TO MAKE YOUR SEEDBOMB

### WHAT WILL YOU NEED?

- Clay (you can find this in your local garden centre)
- Compost
- Irish Wildflower Seeds
- Cup
- Flat Board
- Bowl

### STEP 1 – MIX IT UP

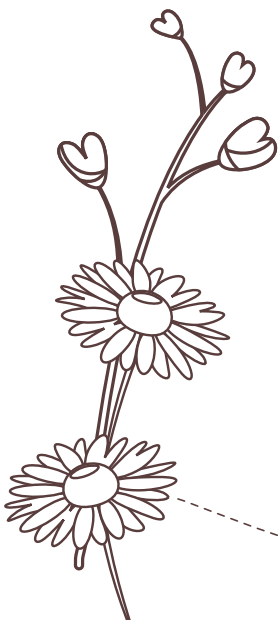
- In your bowl, mix together 4 cups of compost and 2 cups of clay.

### STEP 2 – PUTTING IT TOGETHER

- Take some of the mixture and make it into a flat round disc in your hand.
- Grab a pinch of seeds and drop into the centre of the disc.
- Squash the disc and seeds and make into a ball.
- Sprinkle more seeds onto the board.
- Roll the Seedbomb ball through the seeds.

### STEP 3 – SEEDBOMB YOUR GARDEN

- Throw the Seedbombs into your garden and let them grow!
- In 6-8 weeks you should see some lovely Irish wildflowers!
